

Course Numbers

Course Prefix

For both undergraduate and graduate courses, the prefix of the course number represents the department offering that course:

- “IS” for the College of International Studies
- “AA” for Applied Anthropology Department
- “AC” for the Abraham Center
- “AL” for the Applied Linguistics Department
- “WA” for the Center for Excellence in World Arts (CEWA)

Course Level

The first numeral in a course number represents the level of the course:

- “1xxx” freshman level undergraduate
- “2xxx” sophomore level undergraduate
- “3xxx” junior level undergraduate
- “4xxx” senior-level undergraduate
- “5xxx” graduate-level

Credit Hours

The second numeral in a course number represents the number of credit-hours granted for that course.

- gsh = graduate semester hours = graduate credit hours
- ush = undergraduate semester hours = undergraduate credit hours

Unless otherwise stated, courses are offered each term.
