Key:

Excellent: The student shows a very high level of mastery & performance.

Good: The student performs well, with only occasional need for help or advice.

Acceptable: The student has working-level understanding and mastery, but needs frequent guidance and does only average work.

Weak: The student shows substantial lack of mastery and needs a lot of help to do an even passable job.

Poor: The student struggles to do minimally-acceptable work, even with help, and still has serious gaps in his/her knowledge and skill.
